* Skaters should be able to stand on their own and be able to remain on the ice without the presence of a parent. Skaters will be divided into groups based on skating ability. PreSTAR skaters who have not yet moved to STAR 1-5 will register under the CanSkate program but will be grouped separately according to skill level.

** Additional fees per Skater: Skate Canada Fee (\$38), Group and Individual Picture Fee (\$12)

- Step 1:** Click on the link above
- Step 2:** Set up you family account and skater profiles (this only needs to be done once!)
- Step 3:** Pick the program(s) you wish to register your skater(s) in. If you select multiple skating days, discounts will be applied. If you receive an error message about not having the necessary pre-requisites please disregard and continue the registration process
- Step 4:** Complete the registration process by paying with your credit card using our secure online payment process. If you experience an issue with paying online please contact the club registrar at ssskatingclub@gmail.com. Per Skate Canada Policy, skaters must be registered and payment given to SSSC before stepping on the ice.

Equipment and Clothing

- All CanSkate skaters require a CSA approved hockey helmet in order to step on the ice. Face masks are not mandatory; however young skaters may benefit from that added protection.
- Skates should have good quality leather and lace up (no buckle closures.) The skater's toes should not be bunched up at the tip, and the foot should not feel squeezed into the skate at the sides. Toes should be able to wiggle.
- Dress you skater in thin layers. Ensure pants don't interfere with the blade making contact with the ice.
- All skaters must wear mittens or gloves. No scarves or overly bulky snowsuits.
